- 3. **Priority Three:** Build Capacity of Health Care Organizations and the Workforce to Reduce Health and Health Care Disparities
- 4. **Priority Four:** Advance
 Language Access, Health
 Literacy, and the Provision of
 Culturally Tailored Services
- Priority Five: Increase All Forms of Accessibility to Health Care Services and Coverage

Medicare's preventive services

Flu Shots

These shots help prevent influenza or flu virus. Medicare covers these shots once per flu season.

Hepatitis B Shots

This series of shots helps protect people from getting Hepatitis B. Medicare covers these shots for people at medium or high risk for Hepatitis B.

Pneumococcal Shots

Medicare covers a pneumococcal shot to help prevent pneumococcal infections (like certain types of pneumonia). Medicare also covers a different second shot if it's given one year (or later) after the first shot. Talk with your doctor or other health care provider to see if these shots are right for you.

Medicare Part D covers most vaccines and immunizations. There are also certain vaccinations that are always covered by Part B.

- If possible, refuse any package you aren't expecting.
- Open the box and find the name of the company and any contact information you can.
- Check your Medicare statements for claims for braces.
- Contact the Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP) to report it.
