Cardiac rehabilitation

Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance) covers these comprehensive programs if you've had a condition such as, but not limited to:

- A heart attack in the last 12 months
- Coronary artery bypass surgery
- Current stable angina (chest pain)

Cardiovascular Disease (Behavioral Therapy)

• Medicare will cover one visit per year with your primary care doctor to help lower your risk for cardiovascular disease.

Cardiovascular Disease Screenings

• This can help determine if you're at risk for a heart attack or stroke. If you're at risk, there are steps you can take to prevent these conditions.



The Medicare Advantage Open Enrollment period begins *January* 1st and ends on March 31st.


If you are currently enrolled into a Medicare Advantage plan, you can switch to a different Medicare Advantage Plan or switch to Original Medicare.
